

FREIGHT HOUSE IS UNDER WAY

Large Force at Work on Depot for
Northwestern Railway.

PLACE GOOD FOUNDATIONS

Old Walsh Bottling House Torn
Away for the Structure.

The construction of the freight house of the Chicago & Northwestern railroad is well under way now. There is a large force of men at work on the foundations, which are to be extremely strong. The foundations around the building's edge are almost two feet in thickness and about five feet in depth.

There are center foundations and supports that are also very strong. All are placed deep and on a base of rubble and cement, above which are placed heavy stone.

The old bottling works on the corner of South Church and the Northwestern tracks, have been torn away to a considerable extent. A force of men is employed in destroying this structure. The freight house is to be nearly one block in length and one of the most substantial ones on the Northwestern line.
